Freehold: Sheriff Shaun Golden commended the 31 graduates of the 17th Annual Citizen's Police Academy on October 29, during a ceremony at the Monmouth County Police Academy, in Freehold. Citizen's Police Academy strives to build cooperation and understanding between law enforcement and the residents they serve through classroom discussion, guest speakers, tours of law enforcement facilities and group interaction.
